



# Sight Words Corrections Procedure

When a learner makes a mistake while attempting to read a sight word, you need to correct them immediately on-the-spot.

If you wait until later, the correction is less likely to “stick” in the learner’s memory. Please print out this script and be sure to have it with you every time you conduct a sight words lesson or game.

EDUCATOR: That word is should. What word?

LEARNER: Should.

EDUCATOR: Again, what word?

LEARNER: Should.

EDUCATOR: Yes, should!

We should brush our teeth before bed.

What word?

LEARNER: Should.

After the correction, simply continue with the activity.

Please note there is not any use of words potentially perceived as negative such as “no” or “wrong”.
